The Statutory Instrument has not been put and is very unlikely to be put. Thank you to everyone who has contacted their constituency mp, Burnham, Lansley and Lamb and, in particular, the Merits of Statutory Instrument's Committee March 09.

**Thus statutory registration will not happen.** Thus the UKCP's position is imaginary - it will not happen.

There is still IAPT, NICE and S4H to watch and, as in February 9th circulation, when the new government is formed, everyone is urged to tell their constituency MP why this does not work.

Regx2 position is not a position of no regulation. Please think about your answer to the question 'Who guarantees your practice?' My answer is my training institute: the London Society of the New Lacanian School which is connected to the World Association of Psychoanalysis. Their guarantee is based in relationship. My practice is known within the LS and its development is through working relationships within the LS/NLS/WAP. I do not want some disembodied regulator to guarantee my practice - whether backed with state power or not. My position within the London Society is publicly advertised on their website. The other point for consideration is that this guarantee has to be continually renewed.

Whereas my individual membership of the UKCP given in 2000, is still valid even though I gave it up in 2002. This membership is an absolute one-off guarantee not based in the uncertainty of relationships. When individual membership of UKCP is possible, I can reinstate my membership.....
